



FRENCH NUMBER BINGO:

Print enough copies of this page so that each player has one of these 16x16 squares. Provide tokens (such as pennies or paper squares or small candies) for the players to put on the squares. Each player will need a maximum of sixteen tokens.

Have the students choose sixteen of the numbers from 1 to 20 and write them one per block in a random order. No game boards should be identical. Then the caller will call out random numbers in French and the students will place a marker on the square if they have that number. First player to get four in a row wins. (Other options for winning patterns include “four corners” where each corner square must be filled, and “postage stamp” where you must get a 4x4 block.)
