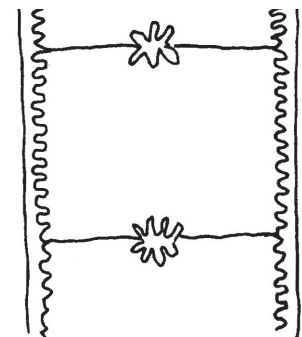
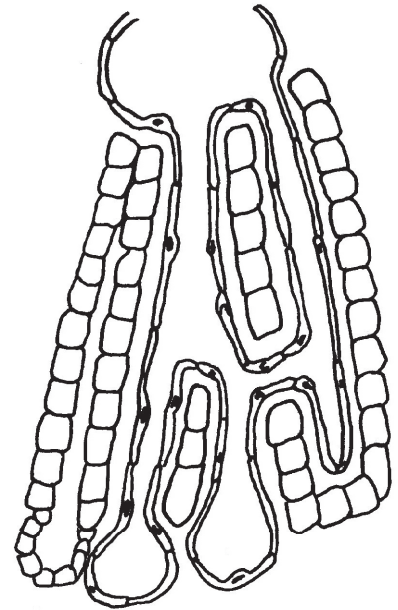
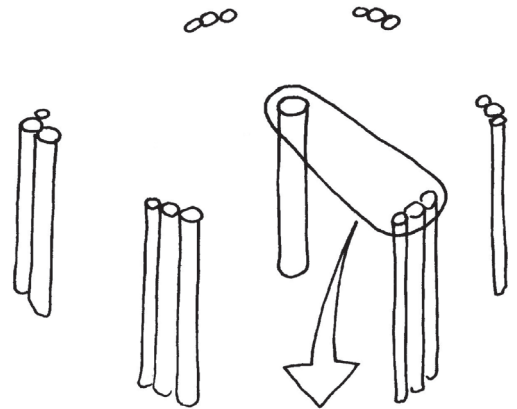
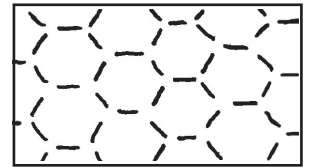
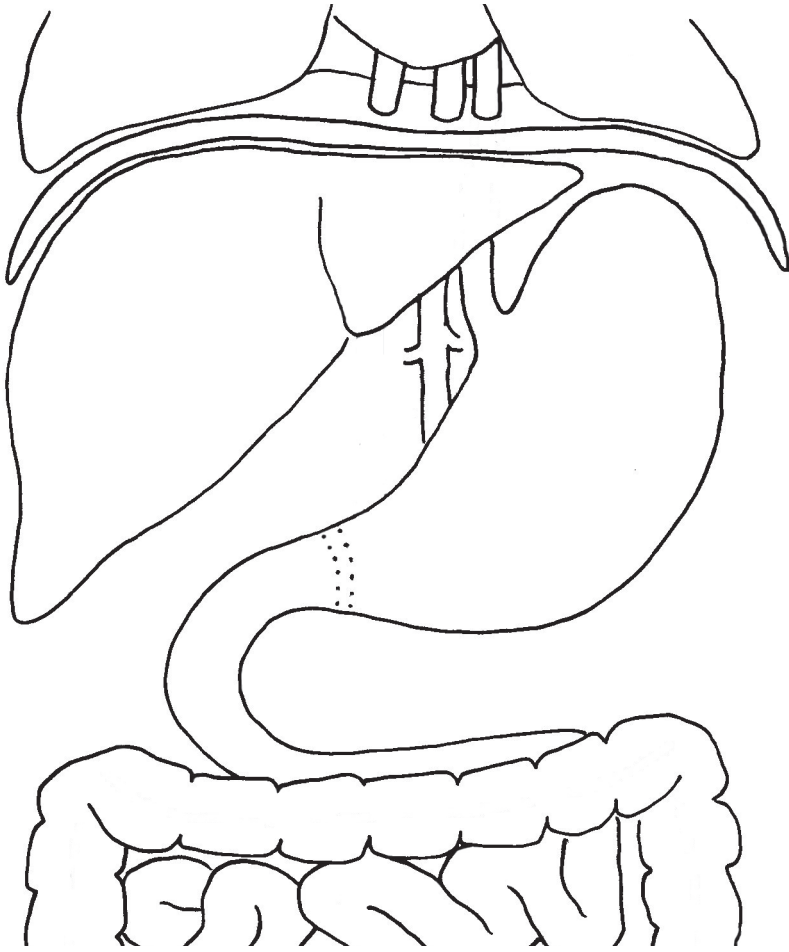


THE LIVER and GALL BLADDER
