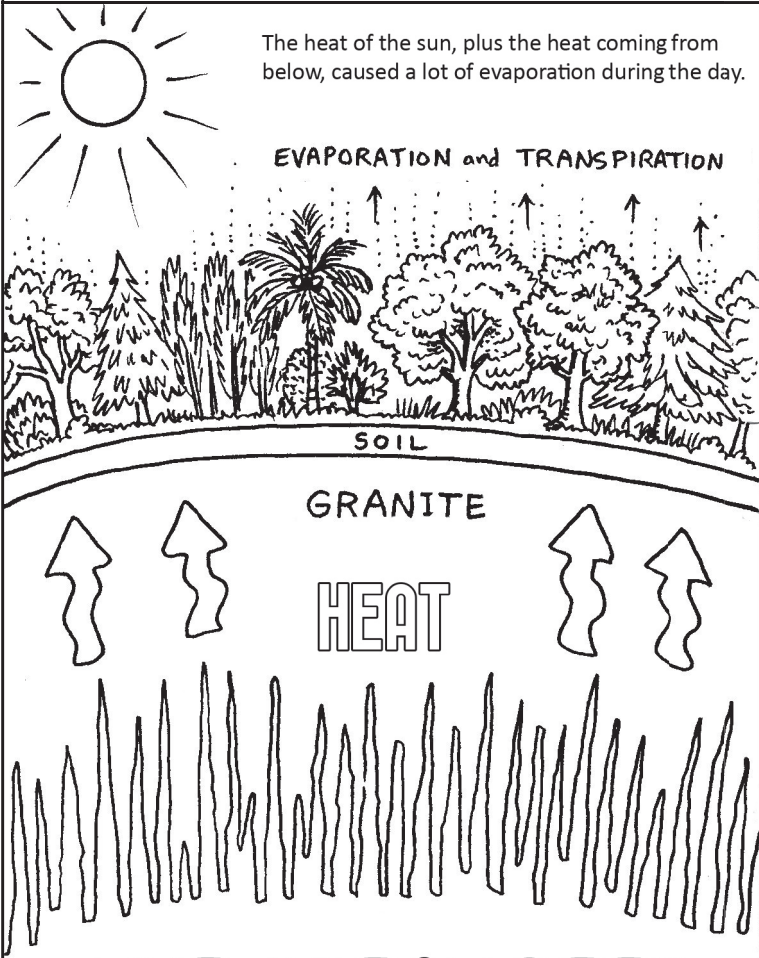


BEFORE THE FLOOD

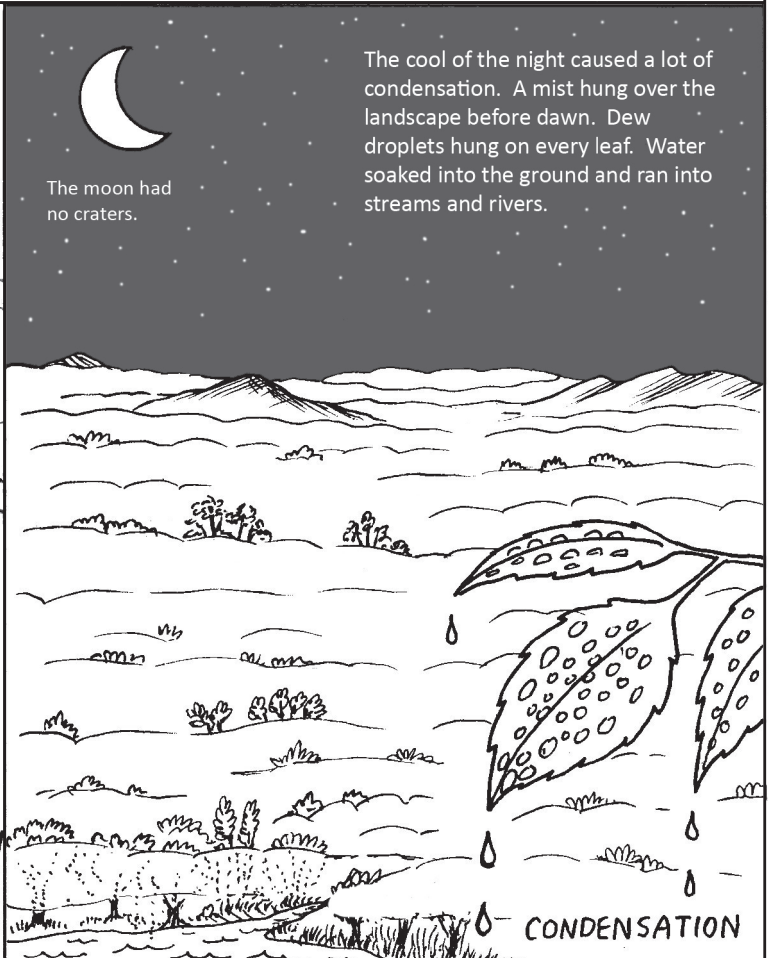

is super critically HOT, due to tidal pumping by the moon.

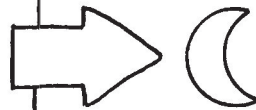

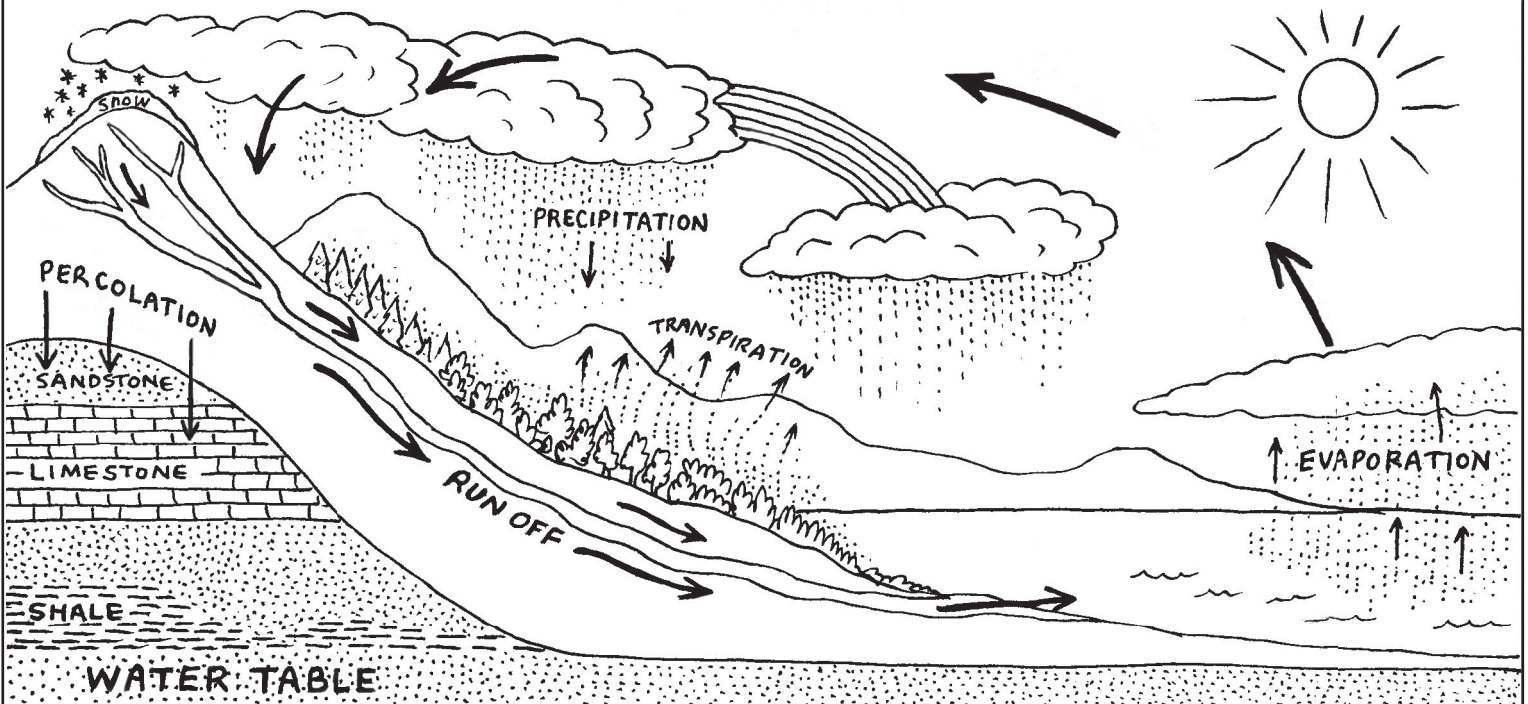
CONDENSATION
